About the Graduate Level Clinical Internship Role:

Bridgeview's program provides clinical training in the areas of group therapy and group psychoeducation, as well as individual therapy and peer support groups in a drop-in center setting. Practicum students have the opportunity to create group curriculum and co-facilitate a variety of therapeutic groups such as Symptom Management, Depression, Anxiety and PTSD. Opportunities to participate in the DBT program as well. Students will attend weekly group and individual supervision with an experienced clinical supervisor. This placement is open to students who are in need of a school year or summer field placement at the graduate level approximately 14-20 hours per week.

Requirements:

All interns are required to complete our background check process and orientation process.
