\$125 covers the cost for a school age child to receive a single 1 hour therapy session

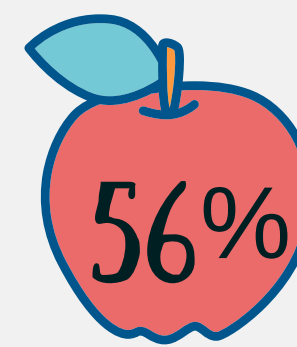
High School Drop-Out

In 2017, LCC led 93 peer support groups, serving 386 students

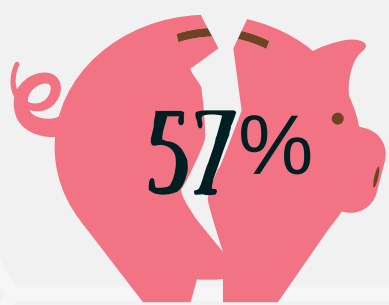


Between 2017-2018, LCC's school program grew by 56%

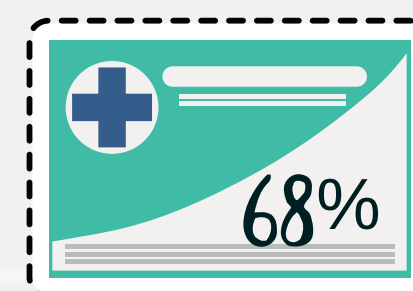
Poverty & Mental Health



57% of low-income* children, ages 6-17, come from households with incomes at or below the federal poverty level²

9,473

68% of LCC clients are uninsured or underinsured

By the end of 2018, LCC will have spent \$100k to support those who cannot afford services on their own

The Cost of No Early Intervention



States spend nearly \$1 Billion annually on medical costs associated with completed & attempted suicides by youth up to 20 years of age¹



In the past school year, LCC's Brief Crisis Program has already seen 17 students from 1 school

\$300

\$300 off-sets the cost of comprehensive care within a student's school for one month

\$3,000

For 1 therapist to receive special training to work with kids exposed to traumatic events, such as domestic violence, it costs LCC \$3,000
