Our services include clinic, home and school-based counseling and individual, family and group therapy as well as psychological testing, assessment and psychiatry.

About the Graduate Level Clinical Internship Role:

Lee Carlson Center's School Linked-Mental Health program provides clinical training in the areas of individual and family psychotherapy as well as psychoeducational and peer support groups in a school setting. Practicum students have the opportunity to train in elementary, middle, and/or high schools. Interns may also have the opportunity to gain experience in LCC's other program areas: Bridgeview Community Support Program for Adults with serious and persistent mental illness and the Domestic Abuse Program. Students will attend weekly group and individual supervision with an experienced clinical supervisor. This placement is open to students who are in need of a school year or summer field placement at the graduate level approximately 14-20 hours per week.

Requirements:

All interns are required to complete our background check process and orientation process.
