About Bridgeview

Bridgeview is a hub for adults living with Serious and Persistent Mental Illness (SPMI). Adults living with SPMI often struggle with the stigma of their diagnosis causing them to isolate from others. Bridgeview offers a setting that promotes social interaction, psychosocial rehabilitation and support.

Staff works closely with participants, care providers and community organizations to assist with access to resources and services.

Who can be served by Bridgeview?

Adults, (18+), with Serious and Persistent Mental Illness diagnosed by a physician or mental health professional.

Who pays for the service?

Membership and participation are free. Therapy services are billed to insurance.

What is offered at Bridgeview?
