By focusing our services in schools from early learning center to middle and high school settings, Lee Carlson Center for Mental Health & Well-Being builds intentional partnerships with schools and communities to help increase access to mental health services and eliminate barriers for children and their families. Our school-based therapists are located within schools to provide therapy on-site to students.

Who can be served by School-Based Mental Health?

Any student with an emotional or behavioral need. Students do not need to receive special education services to use this program.

Who pays for the service?

Most insurance plans are accepted and a sliding fee is available for those who qualify. Contact 763.780.3036 to learn more about your options.
