

## Therapist I (Masters Level Qualified Clinical Trainee)

We are seeking applicants who are passionate, self-motivated, and committed about learning and sharing their clinical skills and knowledge with a dynamic team in order to provide mental health services to children and adolescents as well as their families. We prefer candidates who thrive on working in a semi-autonomous work environment requiring flexibility and priority setting.

The primary objective of this position is to provide mental health assessment and mental health therapy. Work will occur primarily in the client's home, the community and at school as well as at clinic sites when necessary. This position will practice independently under the supervision of a mental health professional and provide professional and confidential assessment as well as individual, family and group psychotherapy services to help clients address issues including emotional/behavioral problems, environmental conditions and social difficulties, as well as perform other assignments. The position will also include working closely with school personnel and other professionals in a mental health care coordination, consultation and training role.

### The Therapist:

- Provides home based, community based, school based, and clinic based individual, family and group therapy to clients.
- Completes diagnostic assessment including assessment of mental health concerns, treatment plans, CASIs, DQs, and all required charting and insurance documentation in a timely manner.
- Provides in service training to school staff as needed.
- Provides referrals to navigators for MN Sure if families do not have health insurance.
- Collaborates on care coordination with school and other involved professionals
- Attends school meetings (IEP meetings, Student Intervention team, etc.)
- Provides consultations with parents and school staff
- Provides psychoeducation services to parents and clinical care consultation services to the treatment team.
- Offers mental health crisis intervention

**Education and/or Experience Required:** Qualified Masters Level Clinical Trainee actively working towards licensure as a Mental Health Professional in one of the following disciplines; LPCC, LICSW, LP, or LMFT
